

# Zero tolerance again for drunken drivers

## Road & Pothole Repairs:

A contractor has been appointed to repair the potholes in St Francis. Work is apparently already underway. The focus is on potholes on main routes. The target is to have them repaired by 15 December.

The SFBRA says the pothole team from Humansdorp has been busy in St Francis this week, especially in Sunset Drive and surrounding areas. "This team is properly equipped and is able to do a considerable amount of potholes every day," the SFBRA says.

It thanks the Kouga Council for allowing this team to be seconded to St Francis Bay.

## By-law Enforcement

The municipality will carry out joint operations with the SAP, especially on illegal liquor trading and on monitoring liquor trading hours. Officers will conduct regular patrols to guard against alcohol consumption on the beaches.

## Lifeguards:

There will be four lifeguards per official

swimming beaches. Dates still to be finalised. Official operating times: 9 am to 6 pm

Bathers are asked not to swim alone or in remote areas as they may be out of sight of life savers.

## Dogs on Beaches:

No dogs will be allowed on the Blue Flag beach (Dolphin Beach).

On other beaches dogs must be on leashes for the safety of other beach goers and the animals.

Report offenders to the municipality in your area.

## Boat permits and patrols on the Kromme River

Boat permits will be available at the canal offices.

At least two peace officers will be appointed to patrol the canals and river. The aim is to increase this number to four (two for the canal and two for the river) over the peak holiday period from mid-December to early January.



The Kouga Municipality has appointed three officers for the canals and Kromme river to enforce the waterway laws including boat licences, skippers licences, angling licences and certificates of fitness so all boat users must ensure that their documentation is up to date and that they are aware of the regulations. The law enforcement officers can be contacted through the Canal Harbour Office.
