The children of the isolated Kouga farm school, Uitvlucht, had a most wonderful, fun Christmas party thanks to Williams Hunt Humansdorp.

And not only the kids but the families in the area – about 50 families - can also celebrate Christmas with their food hampers received.

The school wrote in a letter of thanks that it was an almost unbelievable and wonderful day for the kids who were so overcome, while the families too were immensely amazed and grateful for the food parcels. And the school says the party was for them far more fun than a day at the seaside.

The kids received a big hamper of sweets and fruits and biscuits and lollies, and sweets plus a Christmas present each. And the highlight for them, besides the yummy things to eat was the water slide.

They showed their appreciation by holding up their presents in joy. And not only the kids but the families in the area – about 50 families - also can celebrate Christmas with food hampers they received.

Uitvlucht Primary School, is a farm school 30 kms from Humansdorp in the Kouga area. It has 48 learners, who almost all travel by bus. Most of the kids

are underprivileged, but at Uitvlucht they are guaranteed of one nourishing meal per day, thanks to the support of Kouga businesses like Williams Hunt. The family food hampers included 5 kg each of rice, beans (dry), sugar, maize and flour, and things like salts, baking aids, soup, tinned foods, toilet paper and everyday necessities.

The school has been supported by businesses operating in Kouga, notably Williams Hunt, Through donations and funding the school has acquired paving, classrooms, computers, toilets, new painted walls, a recreational area and a cafeteria.
