Huge Splash of colour at Quayside Flash Float




Hundreds of multi-colored flash floats turned St Francis Bay's canals into a blaze of colour last month. Photo: Nevil Hulett

We have watched great young amateurs who have competed and have gone on to the professional ranks, we have watched very capable young junior golfers grow and hone their skills over the years and we have watched seasoned players keep their form and even improve their play here.

This year in the 36-hole Stroke play, the

The Match play began on Sunday morning with the top 32 players advancing. Match play winners advance in the main division and first-round losers moved on to the Plate. All players will compete this weekend in the quarter-finals on Saturday morning, semi-finals in the afternoon and 36-hole finals on Sunday.

The golf has been fantastic with players scoring well-under par in their Match Play wins. One golfer excelled coming from 3-down with five holes to play, winning the next five in a row for a 2-up result.
